Number of Transactions*

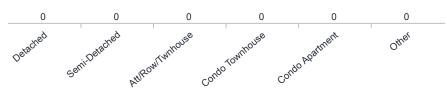
Average/Median Selling Price (,000s)*




Number of New Listings*



Sales-to-New Listings Ratio*




Average Days on Market*




