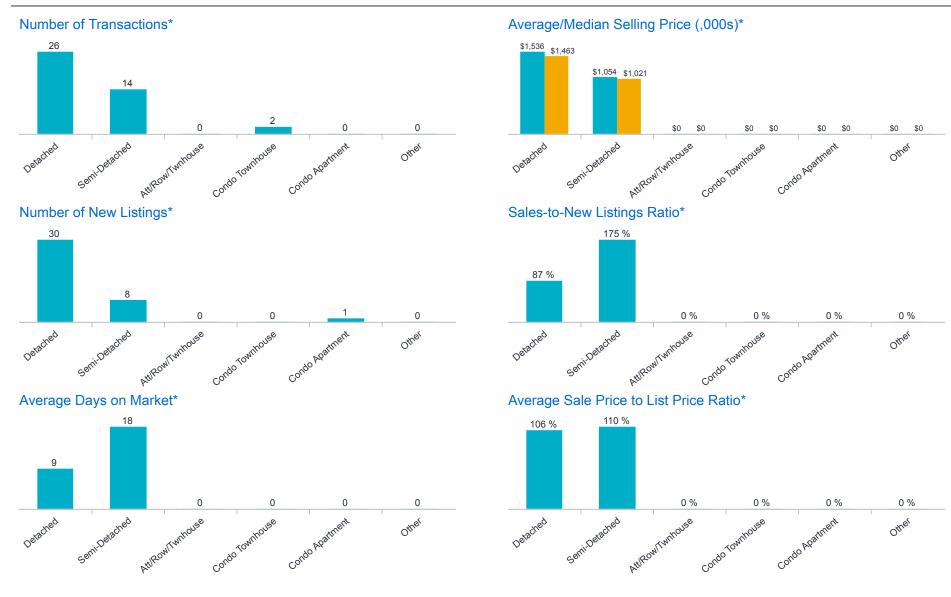
Fourth Quarter 2019 Toronto W02: Junction Area
