- A growing collaboration with RealTrack to provide transaction details for all commercial sales in Ontario of \$500,000 or more.


Modernizing TRREB

This wholly-owned TRREB subsidiary, through the direction of our Board, will effectively receive all non-dues revenue while also paying our fair share of taxes. After-tax dollars will be available to provide enhanced services to benefit you, our Members. PropTx will help ensure we position TRREB to be at the leading edge of data

availability and protection, while also streamlining processes and improving the transaction experience for all involved. Our goal, as always, is to empower Members and improve the quality of services and information clients receive.

Promoting Professionalism

Helping protect and enhance the integrity of the profession is paramount to Members and the Board of Directors. That's why we embarked on an awareness campaign for all things Professional Standards and Arbitration, including easy-to-follow flow charts.

To take the confusion out of common mistakes, the Did You Know? initiative came to life. We shared the dos and don'ts on MLS® Rules and Policies to help Members avoid infractions or address them when they happen.

ur Board of Directors are committed to meeting TRREB's goal of putting Members First. One of the ways they do this is at the Committee, Roster or Task Force level. Their strong collaboration helps drive positive change and growth within the profession.





Stronger Together

The Board of Directors are leaders in strengthening communities. Along with TRREB Members, we support GTA charities and approve annual grants through the Ontario REALTORS Care® Foundation.

- 126 charities received grants in fall 2021 to support vital resources, including community support and medical services.
- \$799,746 was provided to shelter-based charities, food banks and helplines across the GTA.

\$100,000 was donated to the Canadian Red Cross for flood and extreme weather relief efforts in British Columbia. \$100,000 was also donated to the Canadian Red Cross in support of humanitarian aid and urgent relief to those impacted by the conflict in Ukraine.

Red Door Family Shelter Fundraiser

Ahead of International Women's Day on March 8, TRREB's Women in Real Estate Task Force launched a fundraising campaign to help women and children facing abuse and violence.

\$2.425 was raised for the Red Door Family Shelter, in addition to the \$3,000 already donated to the shelter from TRREB's Every REALTOR® Campaign 2021 participation with the Ontario REALTORS Care® Foundation grant program.




Strengthening Diversity

Last fall, our Board of Directors proudly supported TRREB's Diversity & Inclusion Task Force in leading a first-of-its-kind groundbreaking survey to break down barriers and foster an environment of belonging and an inclusive membership. Together, we are committed to improving how we represent the demographics that make up TRREB.

Alongside the Ted Rogers School of Management Diversity Institute, we asked Members to share any unfair treatment experienced or observed in the real estate industry. Almost 5,000 Members took part in the survey!

The results were used to create a best practices toolkit that brokerages and Members can use to benefit their business. The research also outlines opportunities to the Board of Directors so TRREB can continue to guide a better profession for today, tomorrow and onward.
