This past July, the Board of Directors headed to a strategic planning session to guide our mission into the days, months, and years to come.

TRREB increased the number of our signature Market Outlook and Year in Review events to five to better serve the surrounding regions. Barrie and Simcoe County joined our existing stops in Toronto, Durham, Peel, and York. We saw nearly **2,000 Members** combined attend these events focused on what's next for the housing market.



Over 11,000 attendees took part in TRREB REALTOR® QUEST 2024. This signature event has firmly solidified its place as Canada's largest real estate conference and trade show. Our Board of Directors were not only involved in planning TRREB REALTOR® QUEST but they also represented TRREB on the trade show floor and introduced a range of diverse speakers. This event was nothing short of inspiring and included keynote speakers Martha Stewart, Jay Shetty, and Monty Moran.

Professional Development Committee

INNOVATING AND ADVANCING

Our Board of Directors are REALTORS® too – allowing them to provide direct input on what matters most to our industry. They are passionate about ensuring REALTORS® have the right technology tools to navigate any transaction and work in an environment that allows their clients to thrive.

Starting this year, Members are now securely accessing **PropTx tools and services** through a simple login process. A **one-time code** is now sent directly to a Member's mobile device to authenticate and log in to the TRREB Home Page.

The Habistat, a data analytics tool, is joining the lineup of Member benefits. This tool, powered by PropTx, helps REALTORS® easily navigate the housing market landscape uncovering trends, patterns, and opportunities that drive informed decision-making.





Five Housing Wins

The Board of Directors are proud to support TRREB's advocacy efforts at all levels of government on issues that impact buyers and sellers. This year, we've delivered important wins for our industry at the local, provincial, and federal levels.

- Allowing townhomes and six-storey units to be built along major roads in the City of Toronto as-of-right.
- Increasing the RRSP Home Buyers' Plan individual withdrawal limit to \$60K or \$120K for a couple.
- Preventing a property speculation tax in the City of Toronto and a provincewide 10-day cooling-off period on resales.
- Increasing professional standards and consumer protection through a new real estate act.
- Introducing legislation to speed up housing choice and supply, including modular and prefab housing developments.



LEARNING AND GROWING

Maintaining a high level of professionalism is central to our mission. The Board of Directors ensures that Members have access to ample learning opportunities, accessible anytime and anywhere.

The PropTx Learning Academy now offers four REALMTM modules, plus a module specifically for Add/Edit – allowing REALTORS® to learn at their own pace with interactive elements, step-by-step instructions, and helpful quizzes.

When a change happens in our industry, the Board of Directors helps us spread the word about our Hubs featuring resources to support Members through the transition.

This year, Stratus users officially moved to REALM TM . TRREB's dedicated one-click access from the Home Page to the REALM TM Hub is filled with how-to videos, in-person classes, webinars, guides, and many more resources.

TRREB's TRESA Hub helps Members understand what's new in Phase Two of the *Trust in Real Estate Services Act* through handy videos, infographics, and other valuable insights for Members to navigate their day-to-day business.







BUILDING OUR COMMUNITY AMBASSADORS

TRREB is deeply committed to giving back to our communities, and we continue to witness the impact that dedicating time and donations make. Like our Board of Directors, the passion for making a difference grows stronger with each charitable initiative.

In response to the devastating Alberta wildfires, TRREB donated \$35K on behalf of our Members to the Canadian Red Cross. Donations were matched by the Government of Alberta and the federal government, bringing the total donation to \$105K. Our impact was part of CREA's REALTORS Care® fundraising and assisted with critical relief, recovery, and resilience efforts.

TRREB also donated \$5K to the Ontario REALTORS Care® Foundation's annual Motorcycle Ride for Charity to support shelter-related causes in Ontario. This was in addition to the nearly \$900K already donated this year through the Every REALTOR® Campaign.

Each year, our Board approves the sponsorship of diverse community events to highlight the value and advantages of working with a REALTOR®. The 2024 events included:

- Bright and Merry


