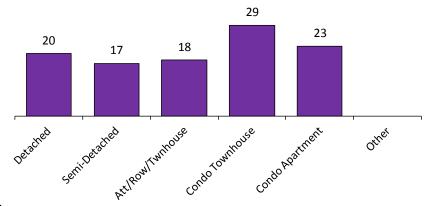

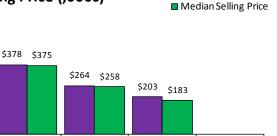

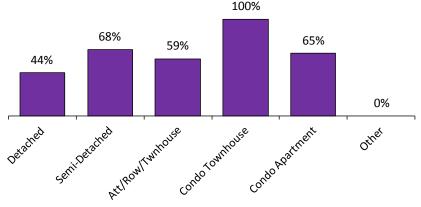

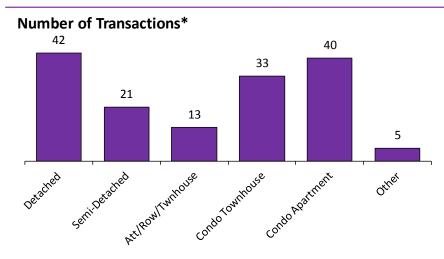


Sales-to-New Listings Ratio*

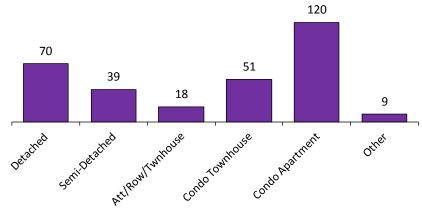




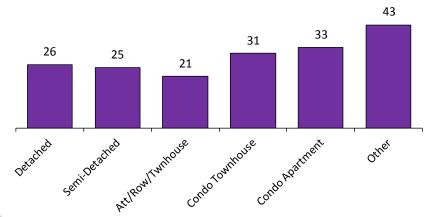

Number of New Listings*



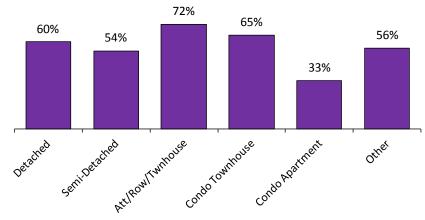
Average Days on Market*

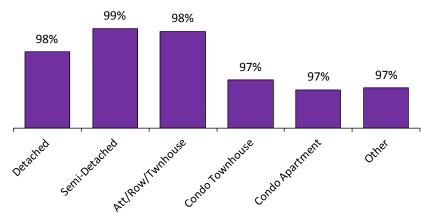


Average/Median Selling Price (,000s)*
