Rental Market Report: Transactions up Six per cent over 2004

TREB's third Rental Market Report, and its first issue as a tri-annual (three times per year) publication, reveals a condominium lease market that has risen six per cent over the first four months of 2004. So far in 2005, 2,155 condominium apartment and townhouse transactions were reported through TREB's MLS system.

While the market is up, rental price trends have been mixed. Rent for two-bedroom condominium apartments have fallen one per cent to \$1,725 per month compared with the same time-period last year; they are also down marginally from the average of \$1,730 recorded for the year 2004 as a whole. On the other hand, rent for two-bedroom townhouses have risen four per cent over the first part of 2004, to \$1,694 per month; they are up nine per cent over the \$1,551 recorded for 2004 as a whole.

- Of the 2,155 leased transactions, 1,975 have been condominium apartments, and 180 condominium townhouses.
- Apartment rentals across the Greater Toronto Area ranged from \$925 per month for bachelor units in the West end, to \$3,241 for three-bedroom units in the Central area. Townhouse prices ranged from \$870 to \$2,151 per month.
- As has historically been the case, the vast majority of condo-apartments leased (1,229) were within the Central

area, while most townhouses (89) were leased in the West districts. One- and two-bedroom units were the most popular apartment rentals; three-bedroom units were the most popular townhouse rentals.

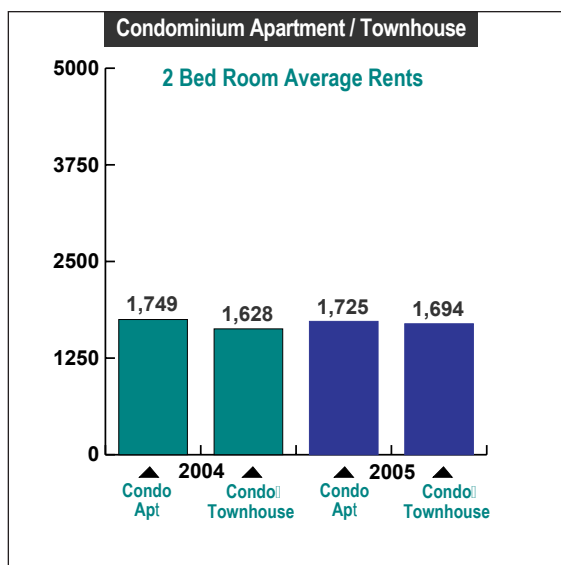
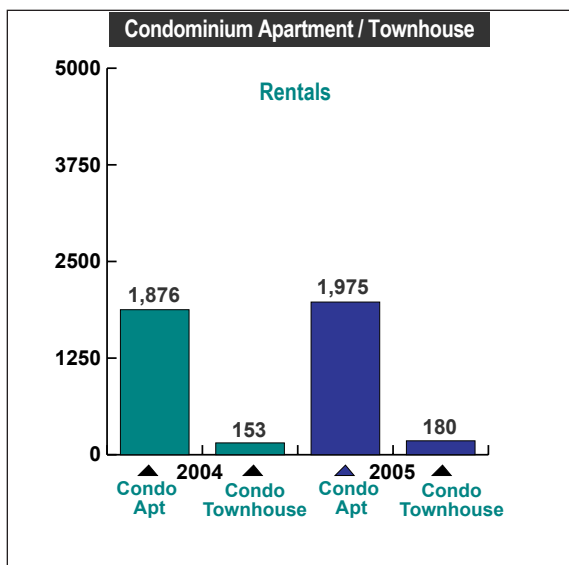
Central Area

- In keeping with historical trends, TREB's Central area saw the majority of rentals during the first four months of 2005, with Central districts C01, C08, and C14 being particularly active. C01 led the way with the largest number condo-townhouses leased.
- One- and two-bedroom condominium units were the most popular rentals in the Central area. One bedroom units went for \$1,369 per month, up marginally from the \$1,333 recorded during the same time in 2004. Two-bedrooms leased for \$1,949, up about one per cent over the \$1,927 recorded last year.

East Area

- The East area saw 197 condominiums and 21 condo-townhouses leased in the first four months of 2005. Of the condominiums, most were one-bedroom (58) and two-bedroom units. Of the townhouses, most were three-bedroom units (14).

- Rent prices fell for one and two-bedroom apartments in the East area. One-bedroom unit prices fell two per cent to \$1,127 per month as compared to last year; two-bedroom units also fell two per cent, to \$1,375 per month. Three-bedroom townhouses rented for \$1,376 per month, down almost 18 per cent from the period of January to April, 2004.

North Area

- In TREB’s North districts, there were 133 condominium apartments leased, and 25 condominium townhouses. One- and two-bedroom apartments, along with three-bedroom townhouses were the most common rentals in this area as well.
- Apartment rental price trends were mixed in the North Area. One-bedrooms went for \$1,194, up marginally from last year; two-bedrooms rose one per cent to \$1,592 from the \$1,573 recorded during the first four months of 2004. Meanwhile, three-bedroom units fell eight per cent to \$1,689.
- Rents for three-bedroom townhouses rose two per cent to

\$1,713 per month from the \$1,681 recorded during the previous January to April period.

West Area

- TREB’s West area had 416 condominium apartment rentals and 89 townhouse rentals during the first four months of 2005. As with other areas, the most common rentals were one- and two-bedroom apartments, along with three-bedroom townhouses.
- Rent for both one- and two-bedroom units were down from the corresponding period in 2004. One-bedroom rent prices fell four per cent to \$1,201 from \$1,246 per month. Rent for two-bedroom units fell one per cent to \$1,521 from \$1,544. Rent for three-bedroom units, on the other hand, rose 18 per cent to \$1,804 per month.
- There have been 73 leased 3-bedroom condominium townhouse transactions in the West Area so far this year. The average lease price was \$1,404 per month, down about one per cent over the period of January to April of 2004. ♦
